Three recent inspections of your facility conducted on June 2nd, June 5th and July 11th revealed several violations of our regulations. There were multiple birds seen loose in the market, severe overcrowding of your cages was noted and in multiple instances there were feces and feather encrusted on cages as well as feeders and water troughs. Title One of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (1NYCRR) Part 245.4(b) requires adequate market caging be available and Title One of the New York Code of Rules and Regulations (1NYCRR) Part 45.4 requires markets to be maintained in a clean and sanitary manner.

This is your final warning. Future violations may result in a penalty.

Frequently Asked Penalty Questions

Q: Why am I being penalized?

A: Your establishment has been found in violation of a section(s) of Title One of the Official Compilation of Codes, Rules, and Regulations of the State of New York ("1 NYCRR"), and/or a section(s) of the New York State Agriculture and Markets Law. Please review your Penalty Notification Letter and attached documentation for more information.

Q: Can I get this penalty waived or reduced?

A: Please put your request for reduction or waiver in writing. *We will not be able to assist you with this by telephone; all such requests **must** be in writing.* Provide any supporting reasoning or documentation with your written request. You can send your request by e-mail to penaltyunit@agriculture.ny.gov; by fax to 518-457-8842 (ATTN: Penalty Unit); or by mail to Counsel's Office/Penalty Unit, 10B Airline Drive, Albany, NY 12235. If you have a technical question, please contact the respective Division directly.

Q: Can I pay by phone, fax, e-mail, and/or online?

A: No, not at this time. Please write your LB number on your check, money order, or one-time use credit card form (enclosed), and mail it to: **Counsel's Office/Penalty Unit, P.O. Box 651, Albany, NY 12201**. We do not accept debit cards that do not have a Visa or MasterCard logo, or electronic transfers. Please do not send an impression/photocopy of your credit card.

Q: Can I set up automatic payments through the Penalty Unit?
