The latest IAP lists 14 total AZDA staff supporting the response which includes 3 department policy group staff (e.g. Director, Deputy Director, Assistant Director). The lion share of the 350 appears to be contractors with AZDA and USDA staff providing oversight and regulatory inspections. Does that sound right? I thought we briefed out on the Friday call that there were 20+ AZDA staff working the incident? If we go down the declaration route it will be important to have all staff working the incident documented on the IAPs and each responder will need to be filling out a daily activity log in order for their activities to be eligible for reimbursement under the declaration. The documentation packages for travel, supplies, services, and equipment expenditures also require things like receipts, account ledgers, and need to be directly linked to the incident action plan and assigned tasks. As a planning factor if we were to declare the
